"Clinton Global Initiative Supports 'Community Health Equity Innovation Lab' in Massachusetts"



On April 15th, the Clinton Global Initiative announced a new 'Commitment to Action' to support a new health equity effort led by Boston-based <u>Harbor Health</u>, to develop a new innovation lab focused on bringing technology into community health centers.

Harbor Health will work with MeHI and other leading Massachusetts organizations from the digital health, entrepreneurship, and healthcare sectors, including Babson College and Baystate Health in Springfield.

The project was announced by former President Bill Clinton in a video on the Initiative's <u>Facebook page</u> and highlighted in the press release on the event.

The announcement was made during a two-day forum focused on "Expanding the Future of Work Today: Equitable and Inclusive Jobs for All." Watch archived video of the forum on The Clinton Foundation's website.





MassCaregiver Coalition "Innovations in Caregiving: From Unmet Needs to Measurable Outcomes"

This webinar was held on 4/29 – a part of virtual series, and builds on the series theme of leveraging innovation to reveal unmet needs and catalyze immediate impact for caregivers.

The discussion featured three Massachusetts companies: Torchlight, iRobot, and the human capital firm Leading Indicator Systems. Moderated by MeHI Director Laurance Stuntz, the webinar traced a journey from uncovering unmet needs, to scaling a solution across families of employees, to driving measurable outcomes amidst the pressures brought on by COVID-19.




Innovation Challenge IV Winner
