### "UMASS Dartmouth Gets Funding to Build New Biodegradable Plastics Lab"

Earlier this month, PrimaLoft gave \$350,000 to UMass Dartmouth to establish the lab. It was the most significant part of \$1 million in funds, labor, and staffing from other private partners, as well as the University of Massachusetts and the Marine Biological Laboratory in Woods Hole.

The donations triggered a \$739,936 matching grant from the Massachusetts Technology

Collaborative to establish the Biodegradable Plastics Lab at SMAST.




## "For the Most Vulnerable, Digital Equity Makes a Big Difference"
