FSA ENROLLMENT DEADLINE

The IRS has recently announced increases to FSA plan maximums for 2022. The healthcare FSA has increased to \$2850 and the rollover amount has increased to \$570.

Please note the following items:

- If you are not familiar with the FSA plan, please take a few minutes to read the "FSA Brochure" that Bonnie sent out on 11/15. Also provided is a list of eligible expenses (one for health and one for Dependent Care) that can be reimbursed through the FSA.
- The limits for the FSA for 2022 are **\$2,850** for Health and \$5,000 for Dependent Care.
- Under the CAA legislation, all unused Healthcare FSA funds at the end of 2021 will rollover into 2022.
- There will be a **\$570** Rollover provision for plan year 2022 – any unused funds up to \$550 at the end of 2022 will rollover into 2023.
- Over the past year and a half, there were several legislative changes made to the FSA plans that allowed for a lot of flexibility including making mid-year changes without a qualifying event. Please be aware that for 2022 there will not be any mid-year plan changes allowed without a qualifying event. Please plan your enrollment elections accordingly.

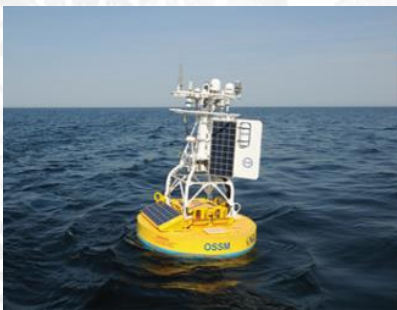
