The keynote focused on the work of the Mass. Manufacturing Emergency Response Team and the Commonwealth's manufacturing response to COVID-19.








"MassCyberCenter's Stephanie Helm Testifies at Hearing of the Legislature's New Joint Committee"

"MeHI, Lever Announce Finalists for the first Massachusetts Digital Health COVID-19 Recovery Challenge"

MeHI and their partner Lever announced the eight finalists for the first Massachusetts Digital Health COVID-19 Recovery Challenge, a new program meant to identify and grow digital health tools that will help drive economic recovery from the pandemic.

The Challenge is focused on finding solutions to help unpaid family caregivers manage caregiving tasks that were exacerbated by the pandemic and more easily return to work.

The program is sponsored by MeHI and supported by funding from the U.S. Department of Commerce's Economic Development Administration and the SPRINT Challenge Grant program.
